

**POLICY OF JUDGE REYES BORDEAUX  
CONCERNING USE OF ELECTRONIC DEVICES**

1. Telephone ring tones and other functional sounds produced by devices (including, but not limited to, “vibrate”) **MUST** be disabled during the hearing.
2. No person may use such devices during the hearing to take photographs, or for audio or video recording or transmission.
3. The court reserves the right, at any time, (a) to prohibit or further restrict the use of devices by all persons prior to or during a proceeding when necessary to protect the rights of the parties or to assure the orderly conduct of the proceedings; and (b) to prohibit or further restrict the use of such devices by any person abusing the privilege to use an electronic device in the courtroom under this policy.
